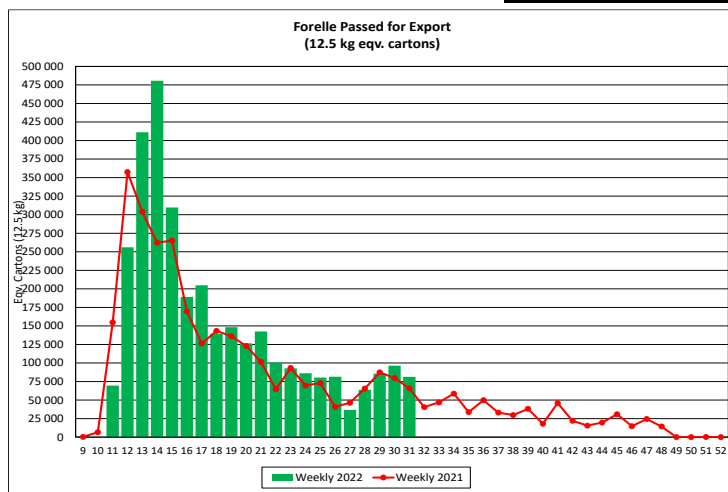
HIGHLIGHTS

- Forelle Inspections passed for exports YTD are up by 16 compared to the previous season. Inspection volumes YTD week 31 in inspection regions EGVV and Langkloof are up 13% and 25% respectively compared to the 2021 season.
- Vermont Beauty estimates are on par compared to the 2021 season. Inspection region Ceres YTD week 31 up by 20% year- on-year.

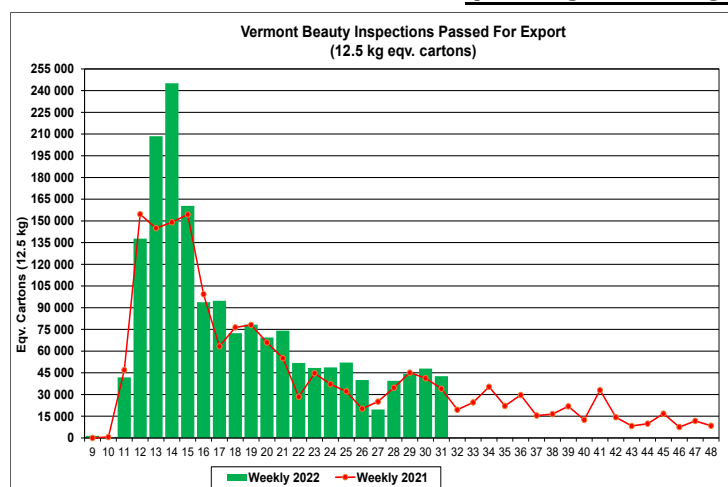
