




CERES FRUIT GROWERS UITSTAANDE ETIESE OUDIT

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Grondpaaie en C19 analogie

In June 2019, I wrote about “Grondpaaie en die Woestyn” giving my take on the different types of dirt roads one encounters, and the analogy with the realities of life both on a physical and psychological level.

Ek reken daar is 3 tipes grondpaaie – net soos in ons lewens: Die wat lekker geskraap is en beter as 'n teerpad ry; die's wat heeltemal moertoe is en basies oorgebou moet word; en dan 'n wye spektrum tussen-in van OK'erig tot redelik swak, maar darem nog nie moertoe nie.

That was quite sometime before we started to hit the Covid-19 grondpad – a further analogy I shared with the Hortgro staff mid-2020 on the C19 road in Namibia. The C19 runs from east to west from Mariental to Sesriem, where it links up with the C14 towards Walvis Bay and on to Swakopmund.

Diè pad, reg deur die Namib, is vir my tipies van alles waarna ons hunker – meestal goeie tot sleggerige paaie maar rybaar om die stilte en *ambiance* van so baie plekke in ons lewens en fisies in ons buurlande, te beleef. Waar tradisionele wintervakansie wegbreke vir baie van ons 'n instelling is en wat vanjaar weereens nie gaan realiseer nie. Eksell gaan darem bietjie binnelands rondry en gaan beslis aspris kortpaaie of ompaaie probeer, om darem bietjie grondpad te beleef.

Back to C19 - mostly a dirt road. The first 100 km's or so between Mariental and Maltahöhe is a good tarred road. Thereafter it progressively gets worse with some very bad stretches between Betta and Sesriem. The last section, a bit better into Solitaire where it links with the C14 which has equally bad patches through the Kuiseb Pass. Then down to the coastal plain and the Atlantic to Walvis Bay and Swakopmund.

Dit is vir my die perfekte analogie vir die Covid-pandemie. 'n Roete wat ons beide fisies en psigies tap en toets. Aanvanklik, die eerste stuk (op teer) wat uitdagend, nuut en stresvol was, maar grootliks OK met nakoming en dissipline op alle vlakke. As bedryf grootliks met 'n vol tenk petrol (volgemaak op die rug van 'n goeie "Mariental" winter) en spoed rondom 100km/uur met so hier en daar 'n bultjie en 'n windjie van voor.

We accepted and mostly dealt with the various phases of lockdown and hardships of staying at home, home schooling and dry cellars (at times) stoically, basically accepting our fate meekly and mildly as a lamb to the slaughterhouse.

Toer raak dinge bietjie rowwer, met al die uitdagings (slegte grondpad) met hier en daar 'n klompie "pot holes" en begin vrede maak met die feit dat C19 vir baie lank met ons gaan wees. Nou op pad na 'n derde golf en 'n inentingsprogram wat maar net nie op dreef wil kom nie, raak ons ongeduldig en gatvol vir volgehoue gebreklike dienslewering en kaders wat hulself steeds skokkend verryk ten koste van die breër gemeenskap wat hulle veronderstel is om te dien.

Now we're not so meek and mild anymore, but we have to stay diligent and disciplined. Let's trust and work together to make driving the real C19 a reality in 2022.
