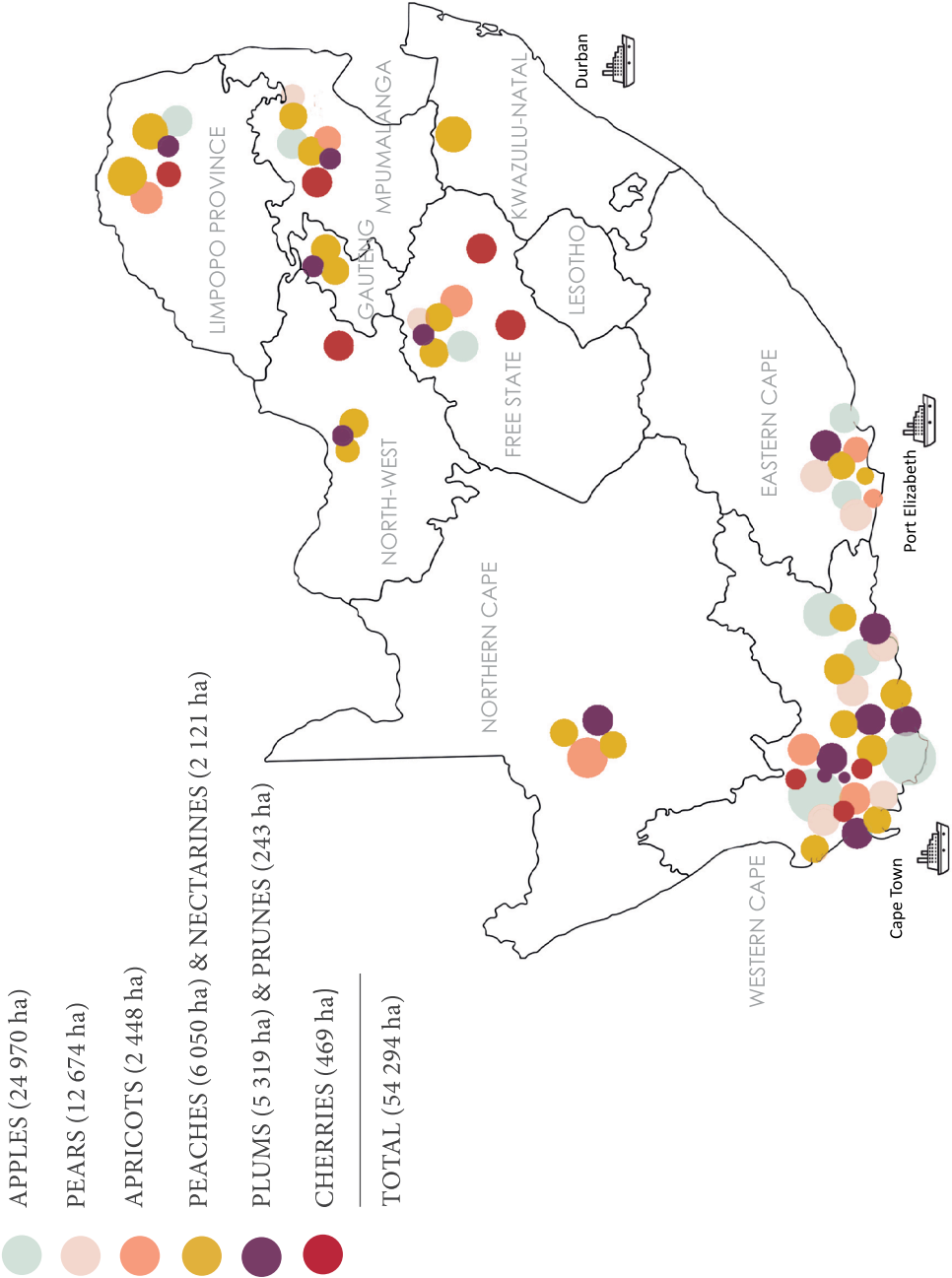

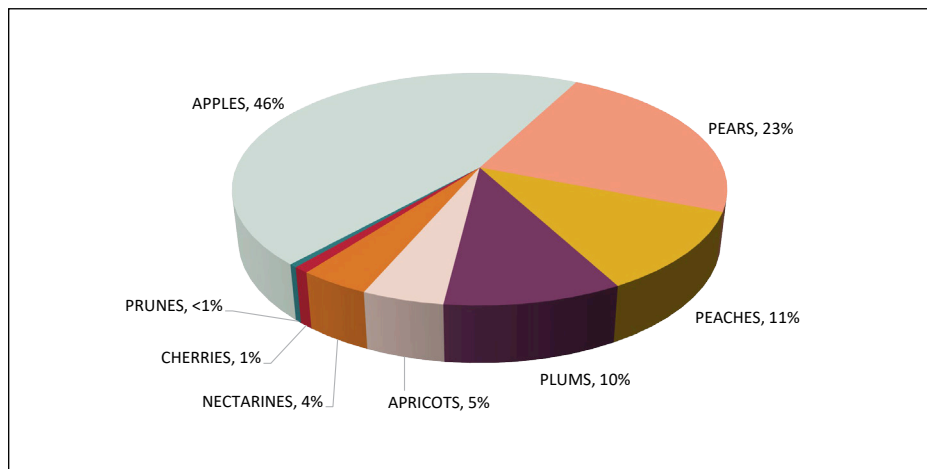

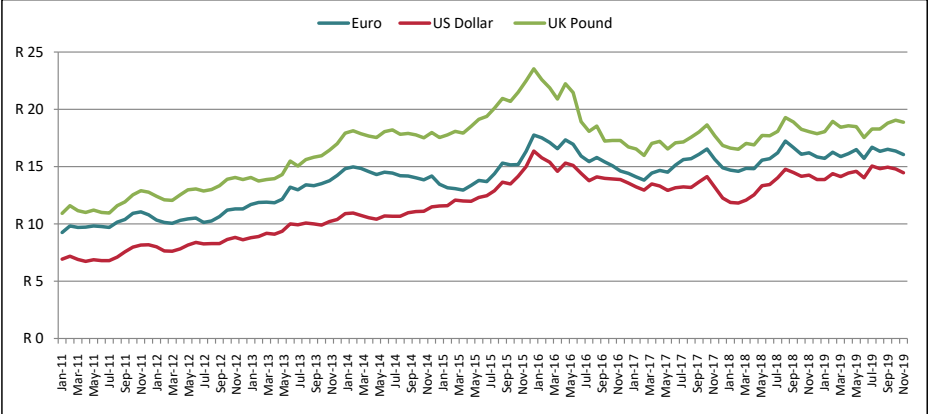

EXCHANGE RATE TRENDS, 2011 - 2019



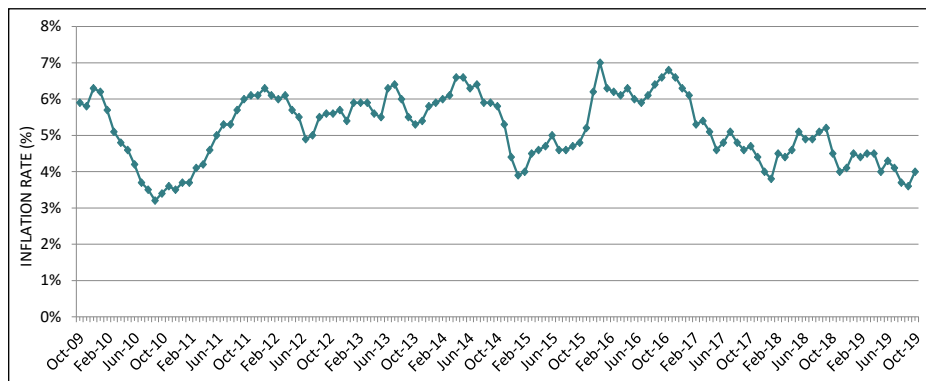

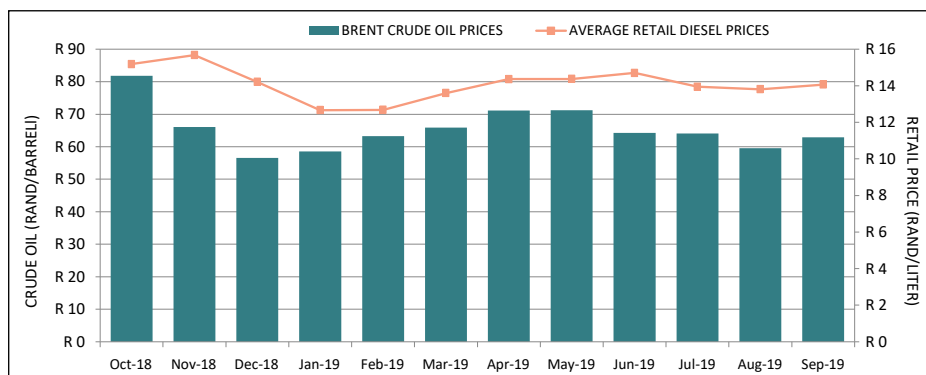

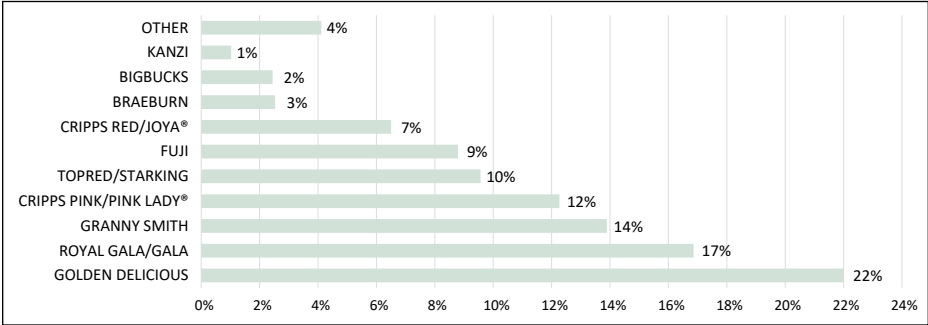

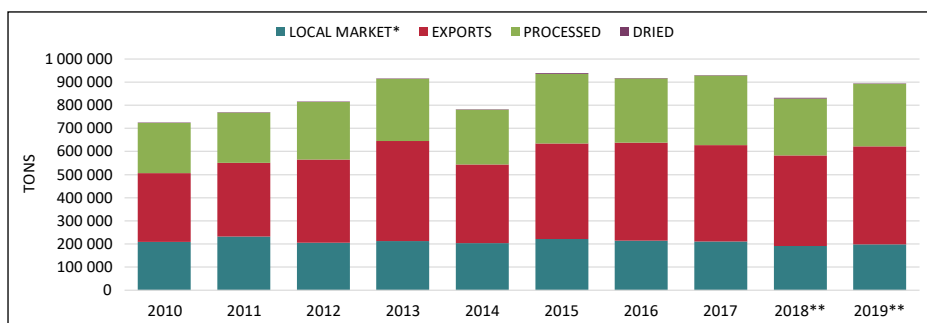

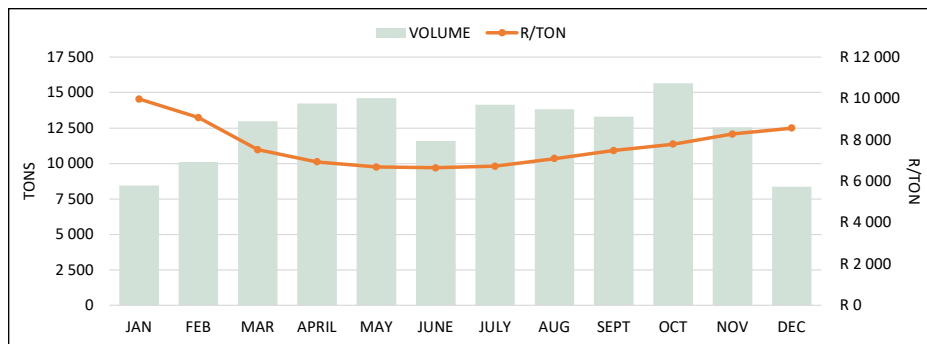

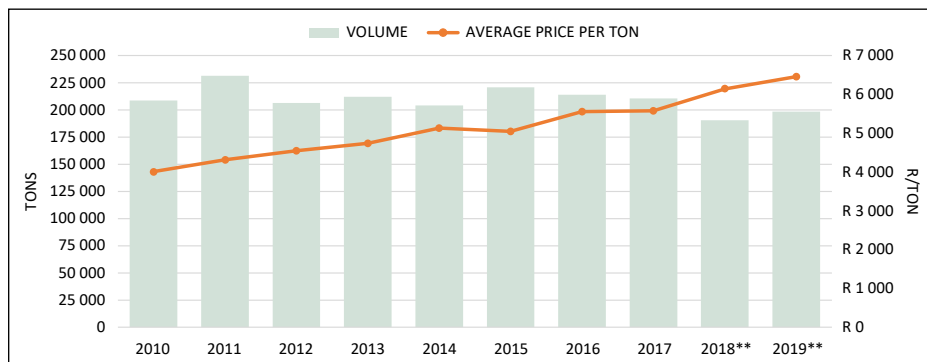
APPLE LOCAL MARKET SALES 2019

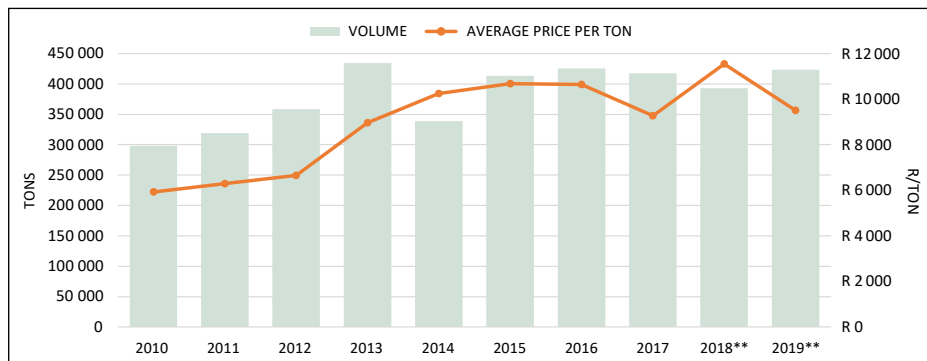

APPLE LOCAL MARKET HISTORICAL SALES



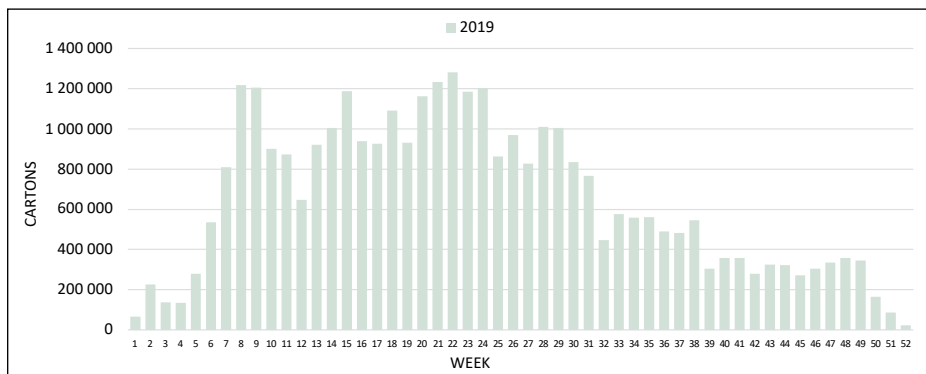

APPLE EXPORT MARKET HISTORICAL SALES



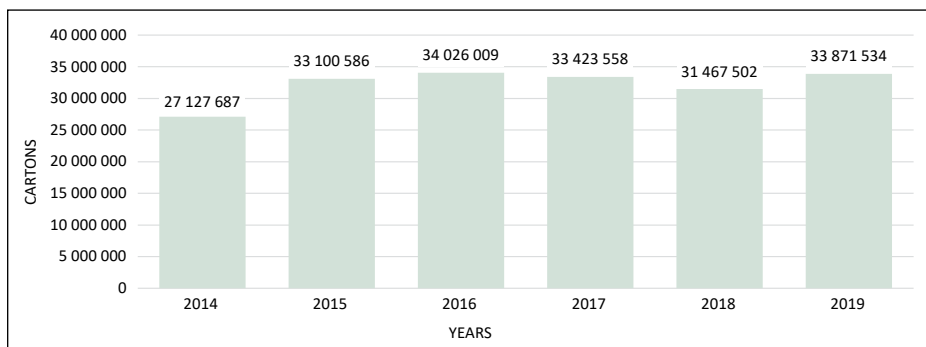

APPLES PASSED FOR EXPORT PER WEEK



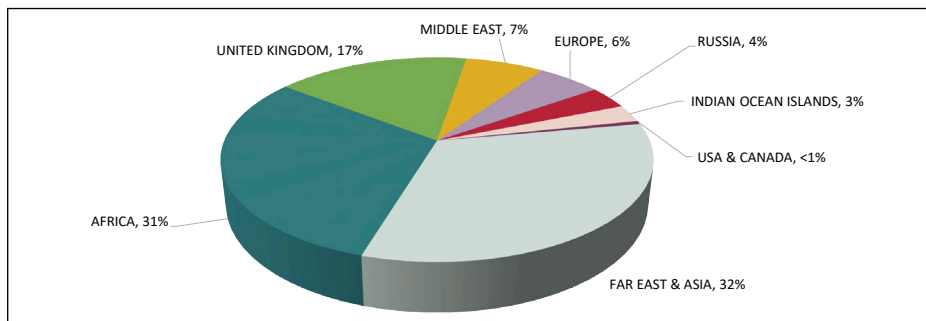

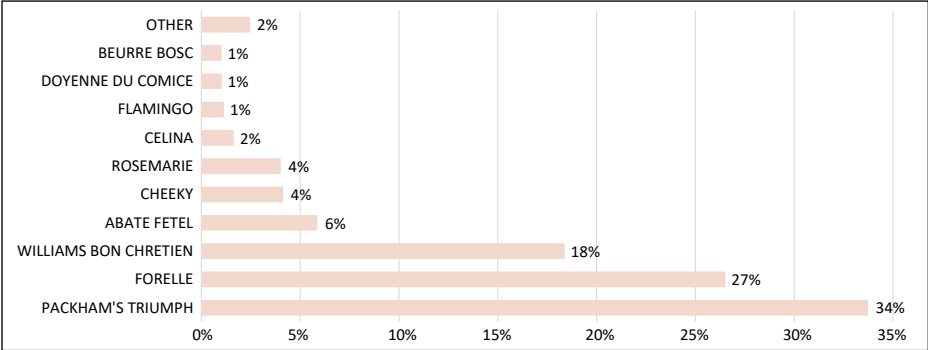

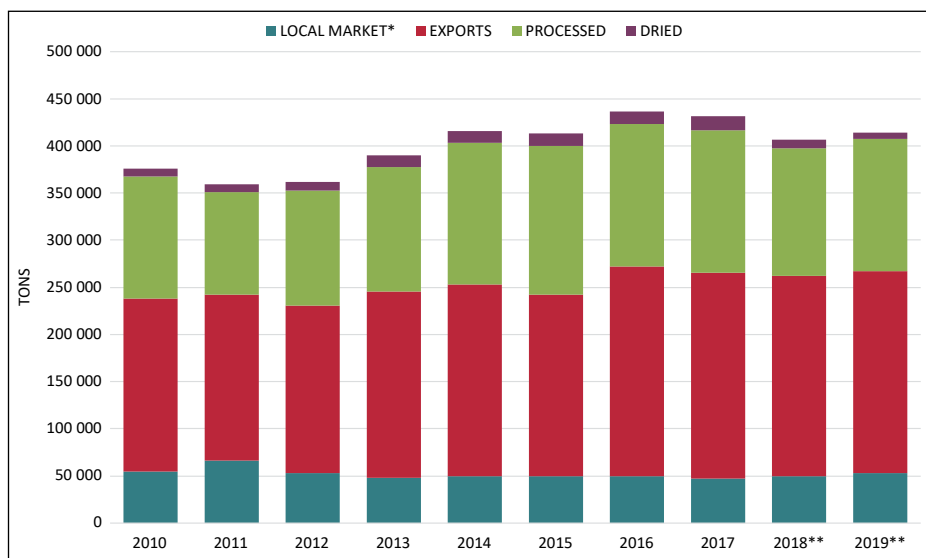

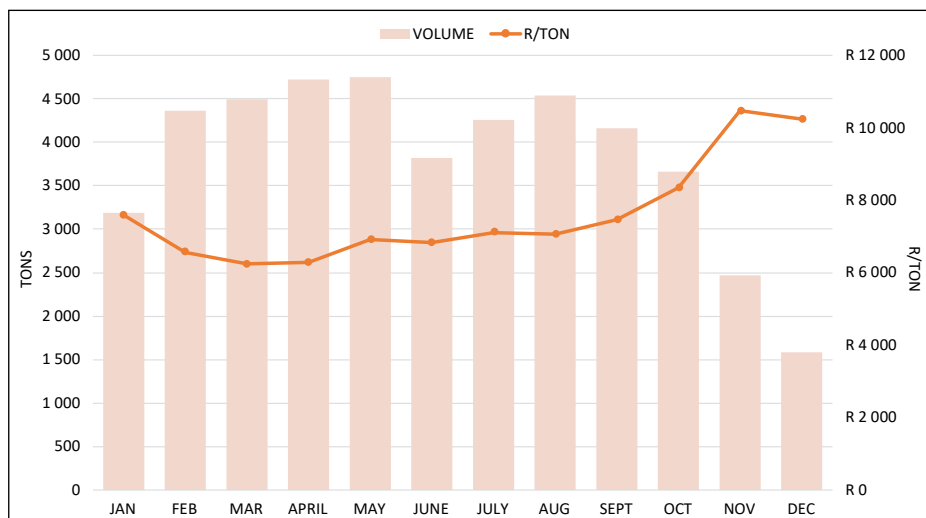

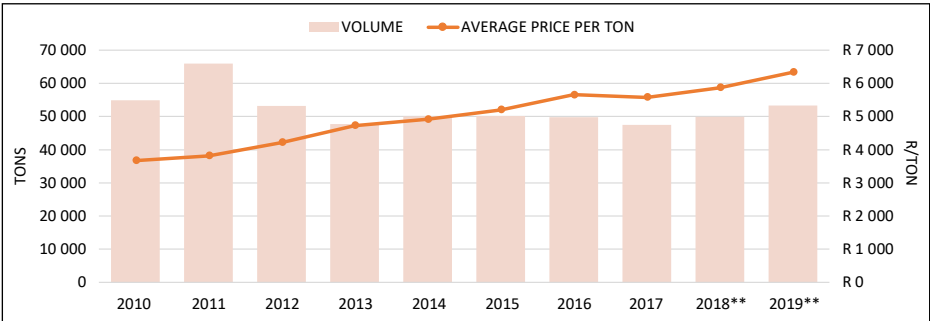
PEAR LOCAL MARKET SALES 2019

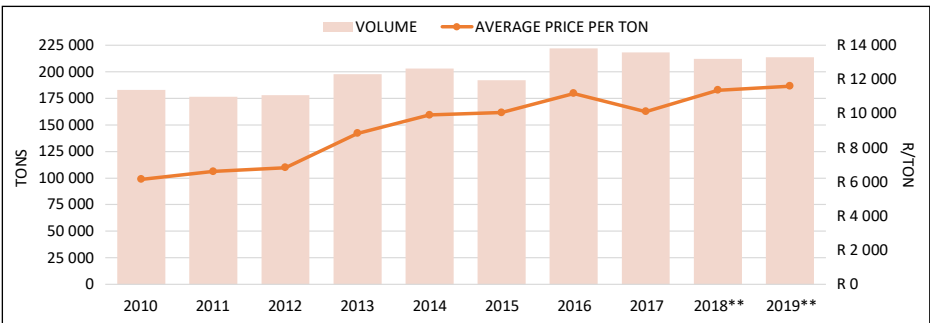


PEAR LOCAL MARKET HISTORICAL SALES



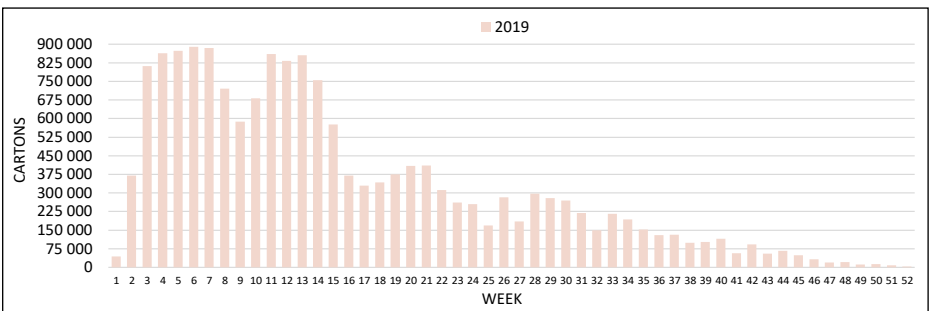

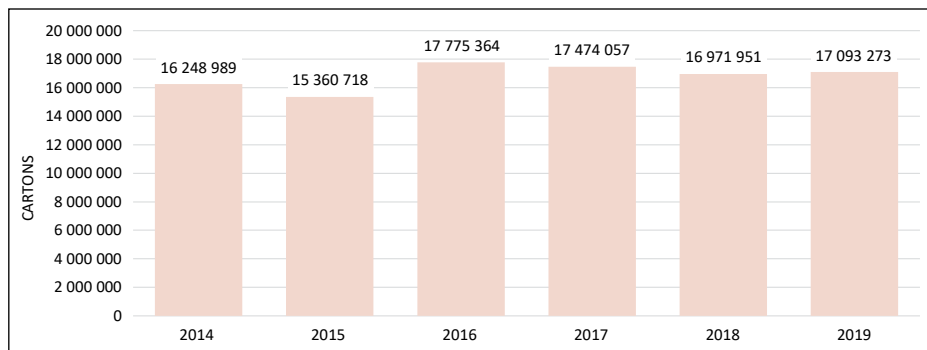

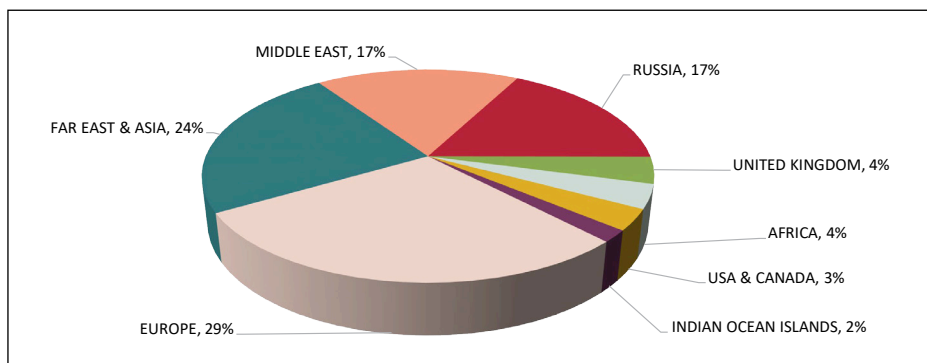

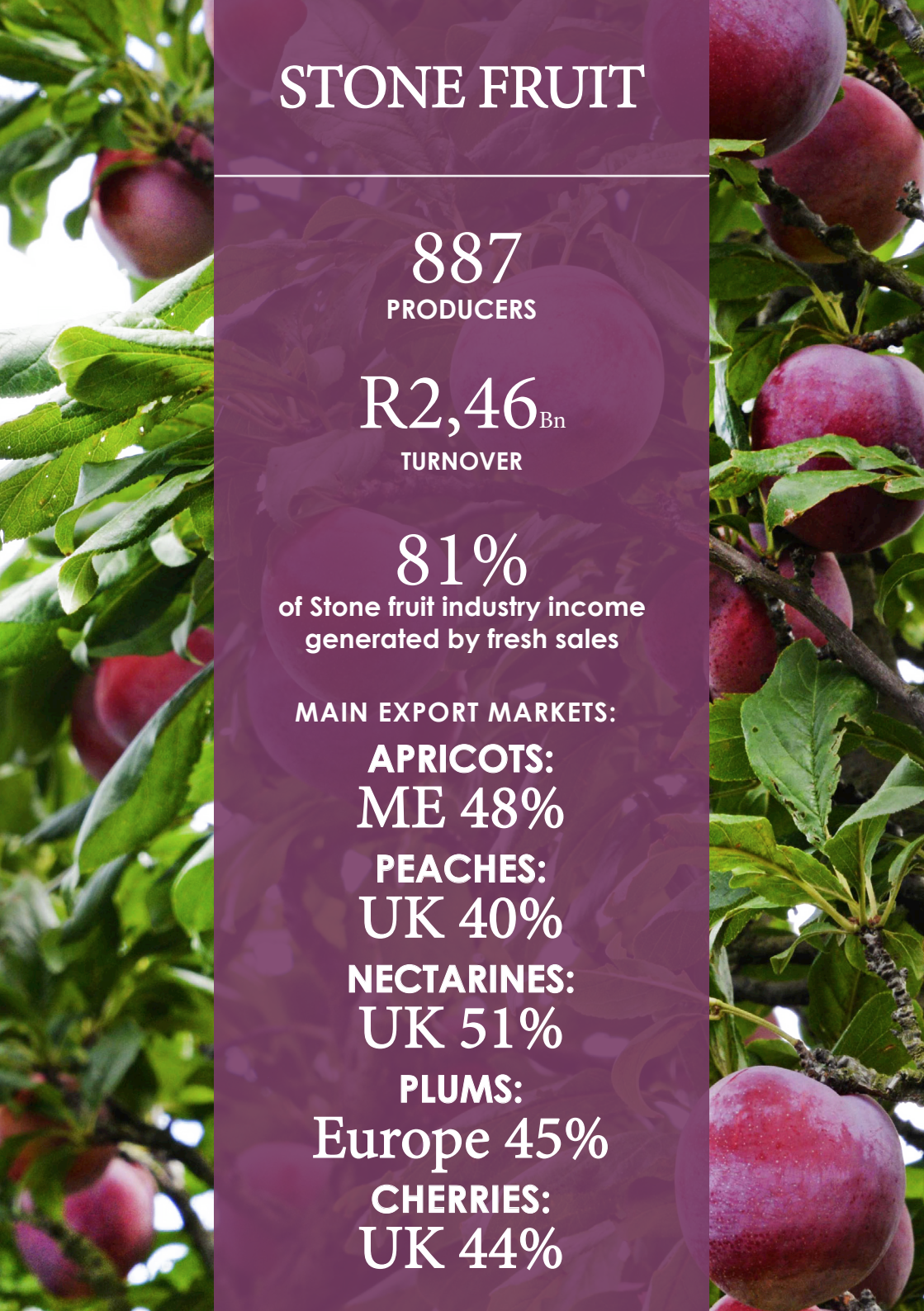

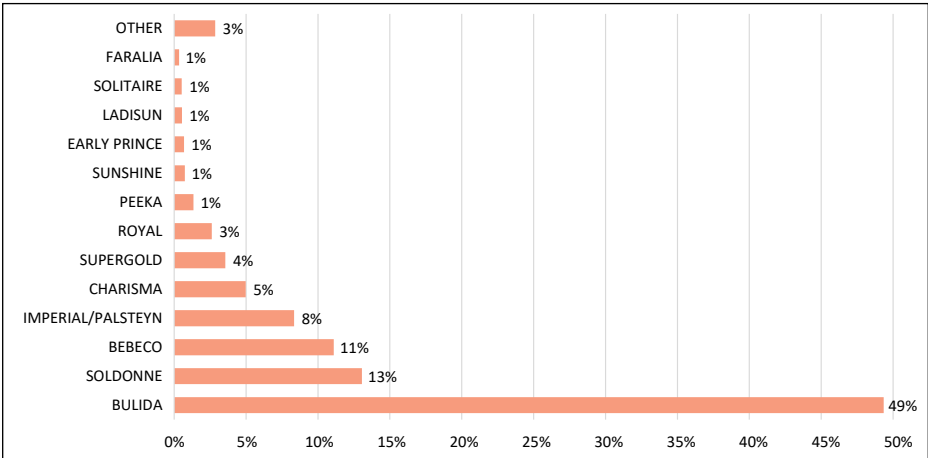

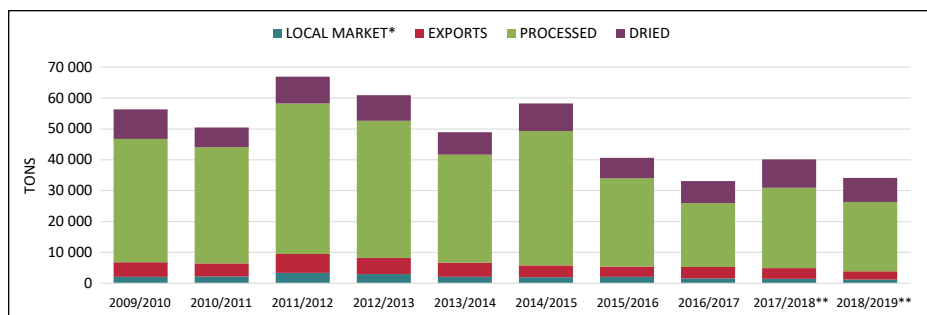

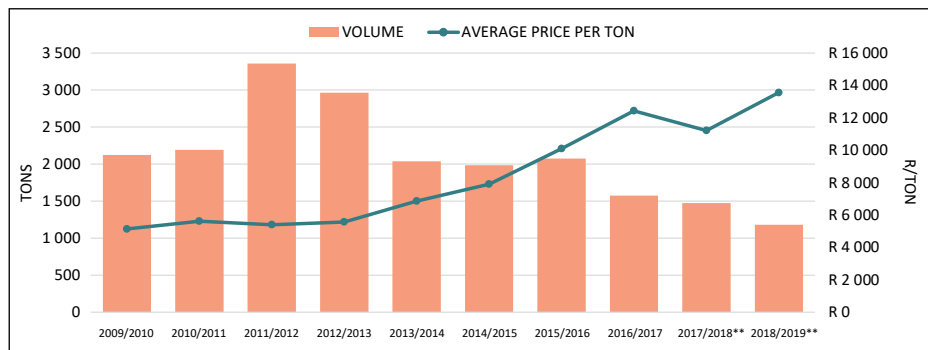
APRICOTS LOCAL MARKET SALES 2018/2019

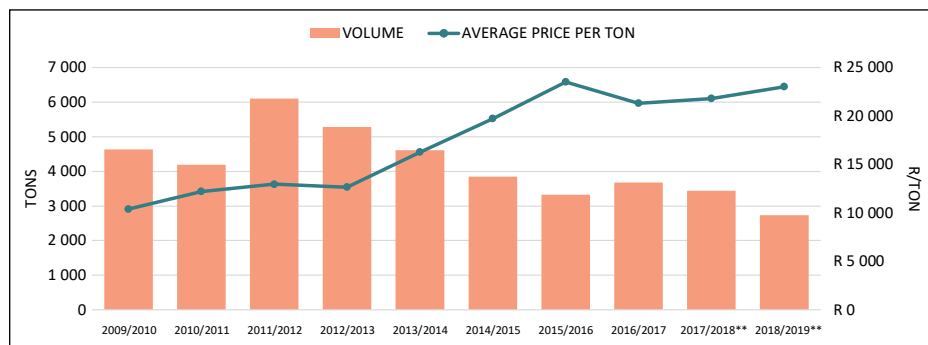

APRICOT LOCAL MARKET HISTORICAL SALES



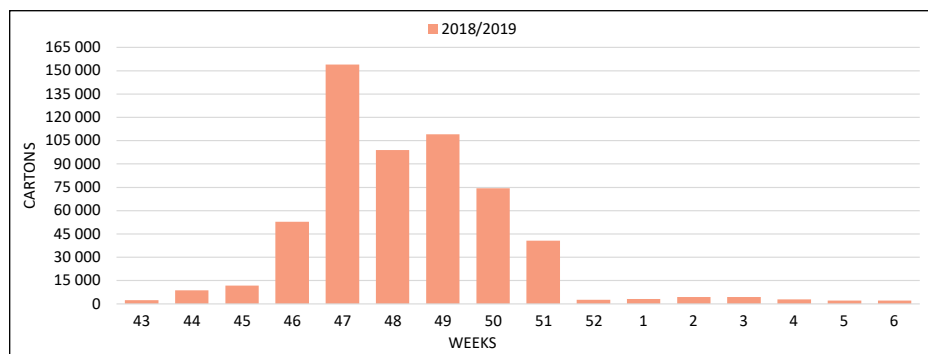

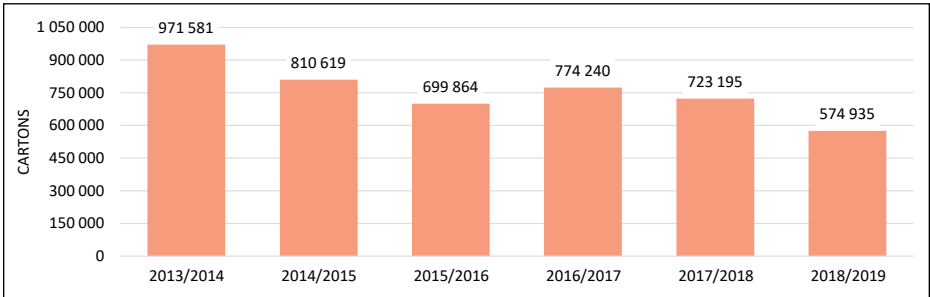

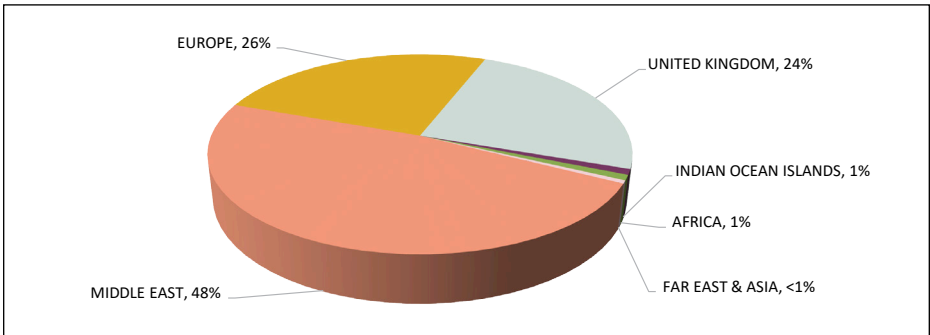

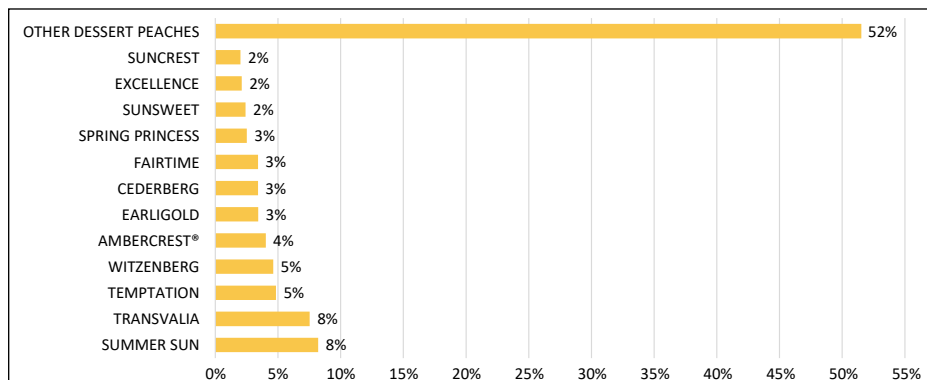

CONTRIBUTION TO TOTAL DESSERT PEACH AREA PER CULTIVAR



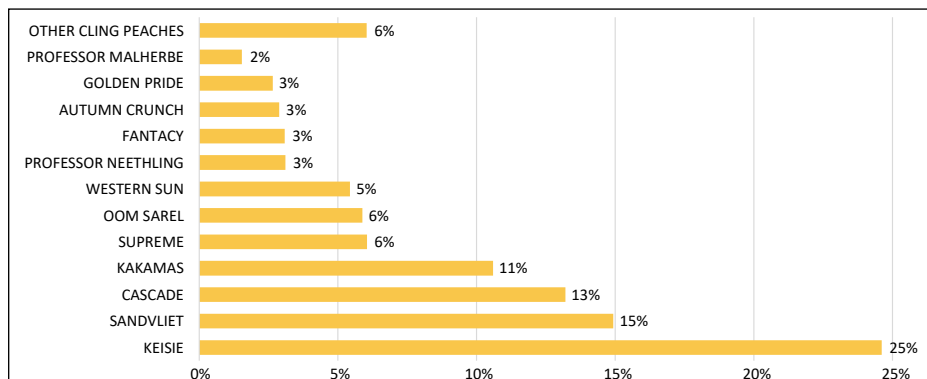

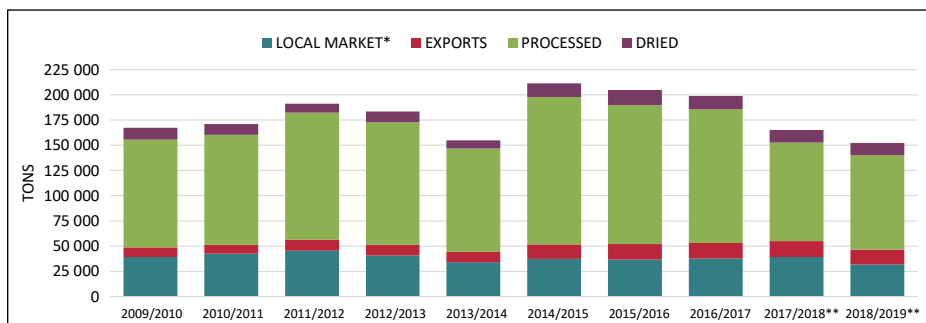

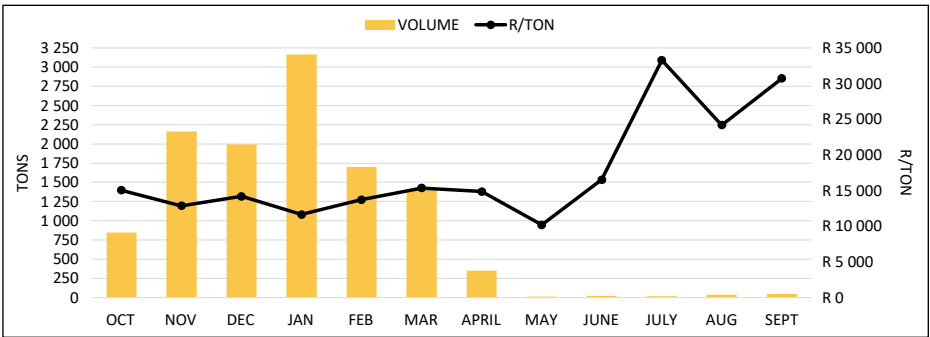

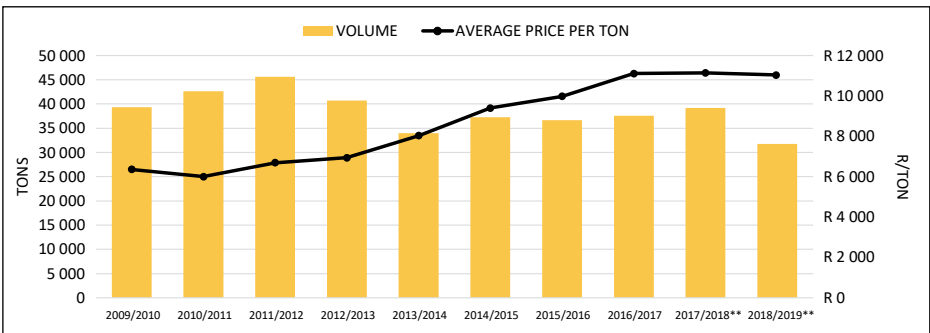


LOCAL MARKET SALES 2018/2019: PEACHES

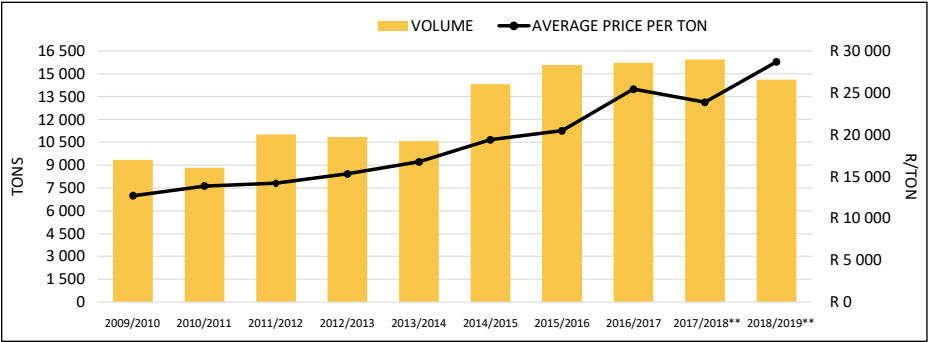
LOCAL MARKET HISTORICAL SALES: PEACHES & NECTARINES

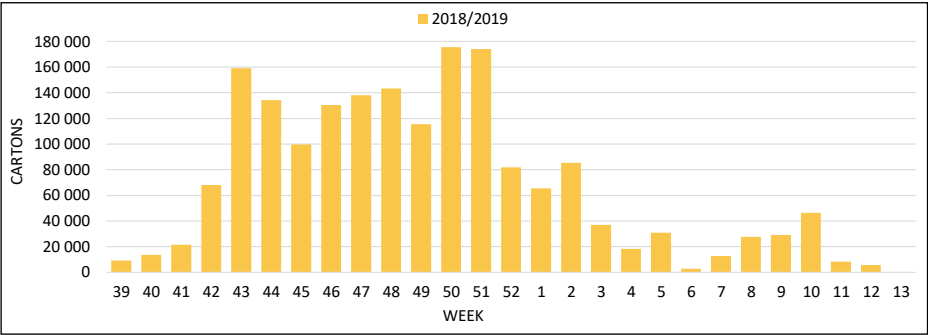

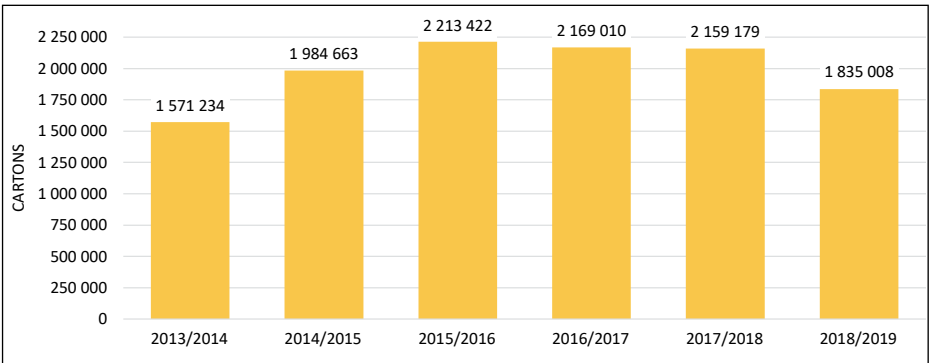

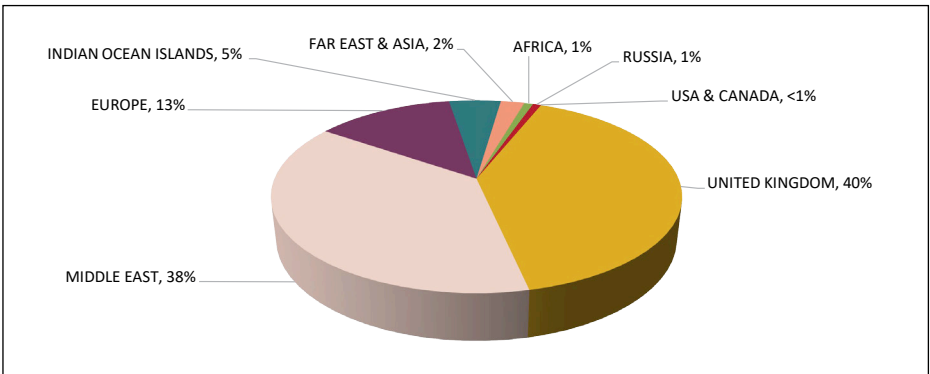


PEACHES PASSED FOR EXPORT PER SEASON

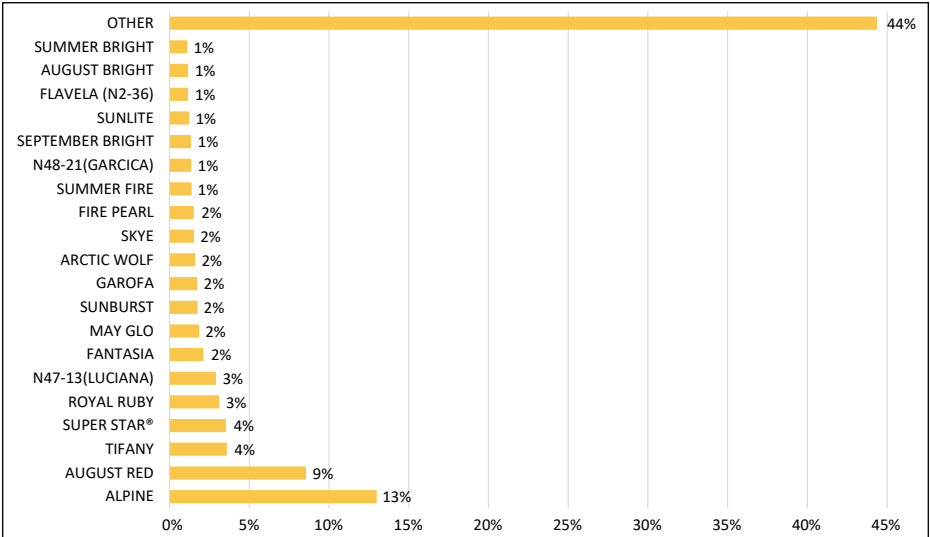

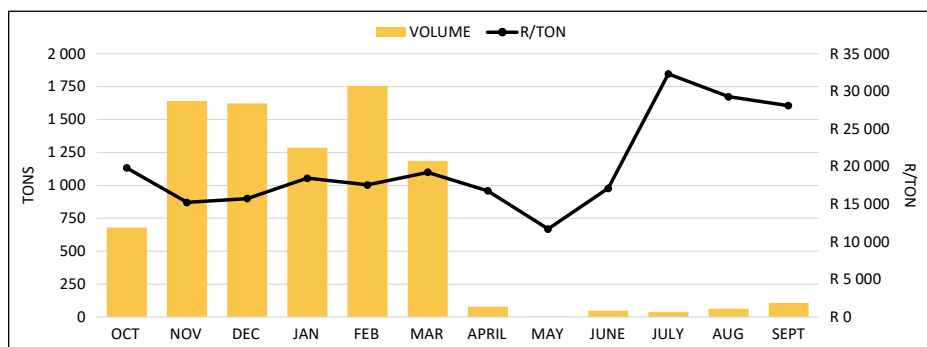

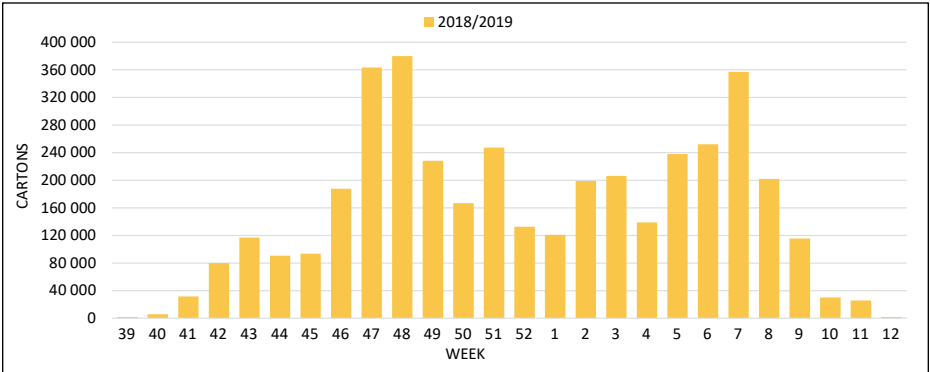
NECTARINE LOCAL MARKET SALES 2018/2019

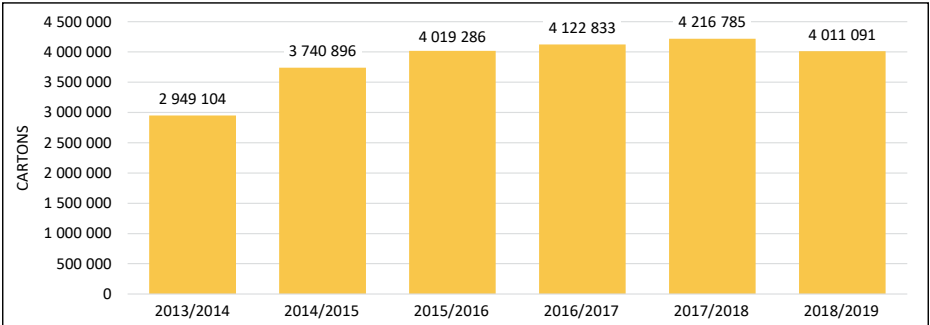

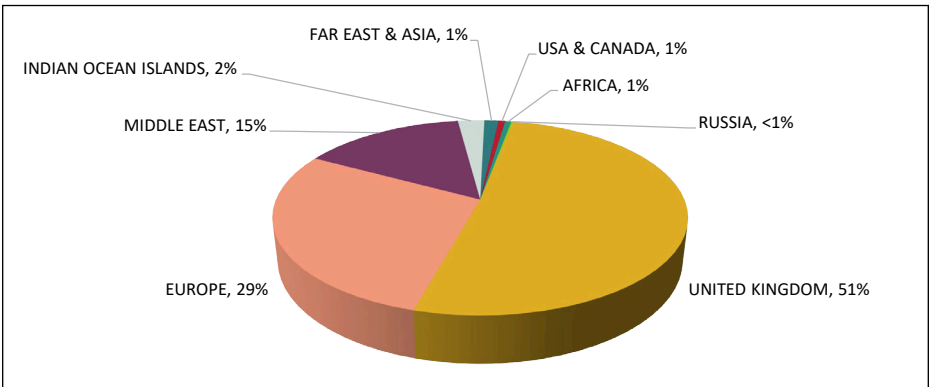

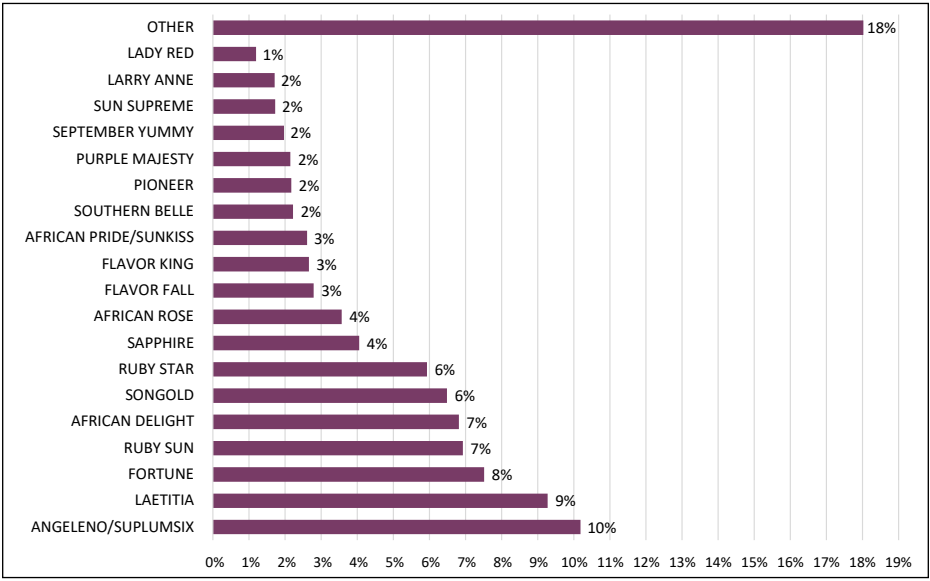

CONTRIBUTION TO TOTAL PLUM AREA PER CULTIVAR



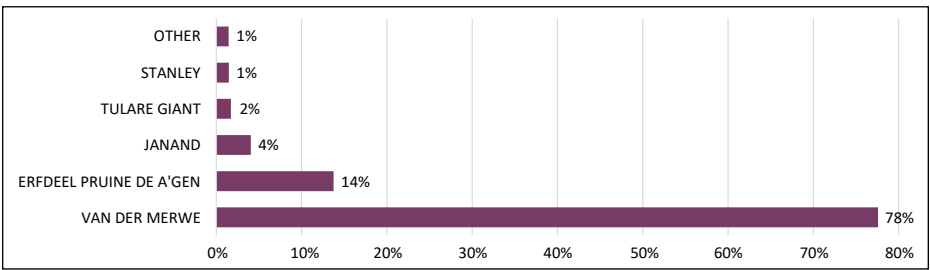

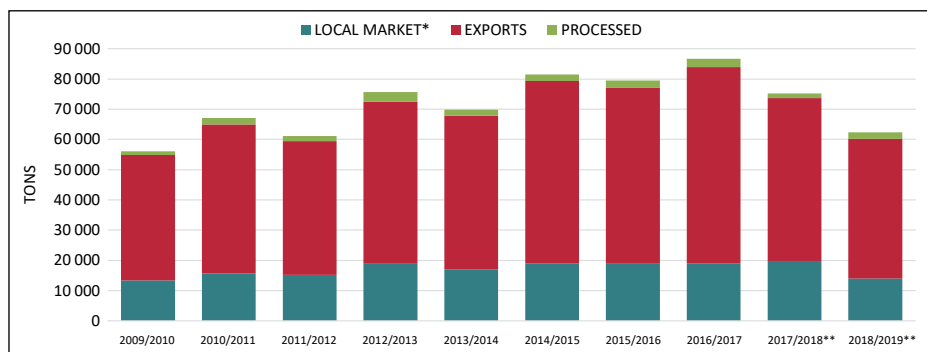

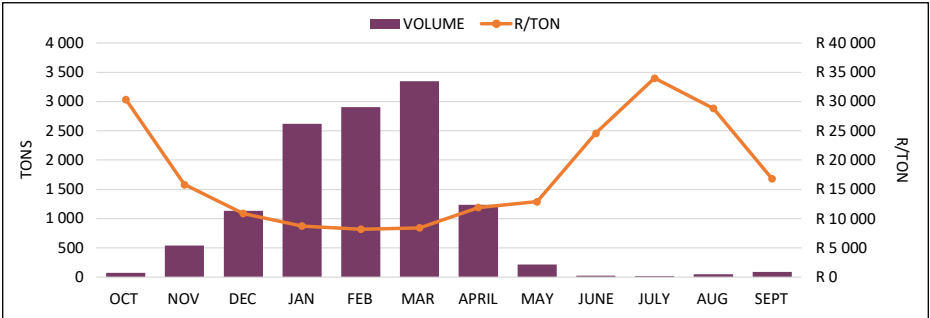

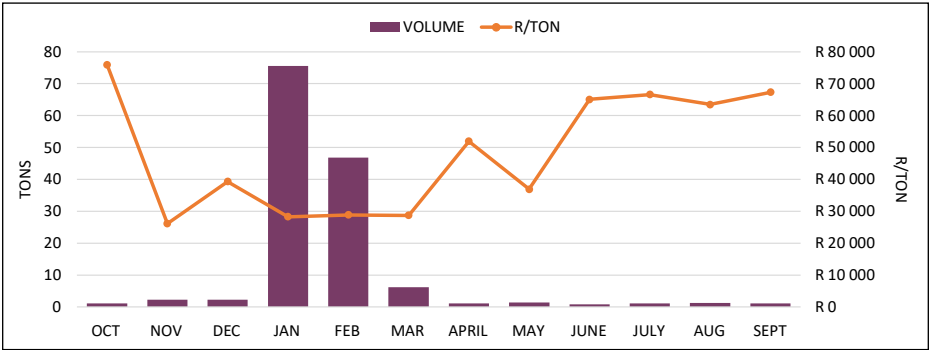

PLUM LOCAL MARKET SALES 2018/2019



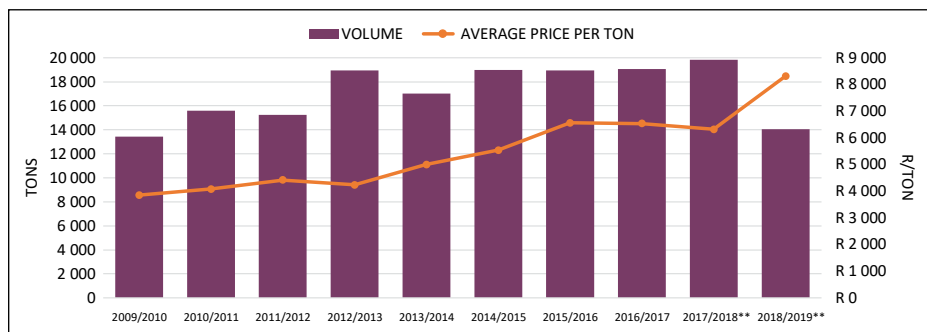

PRUNE LOCAL MARKET SALES 2018/2019



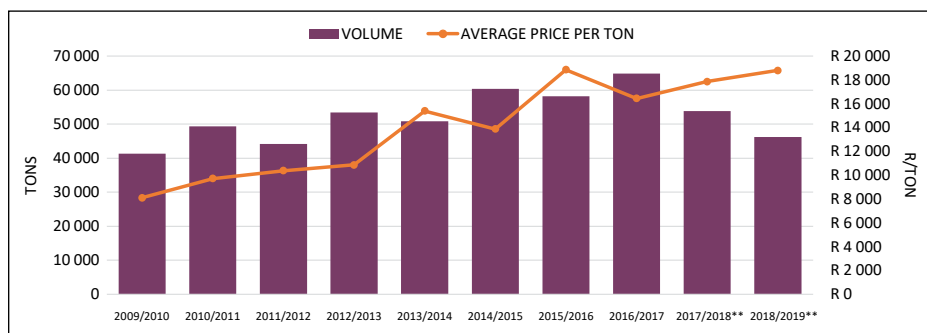

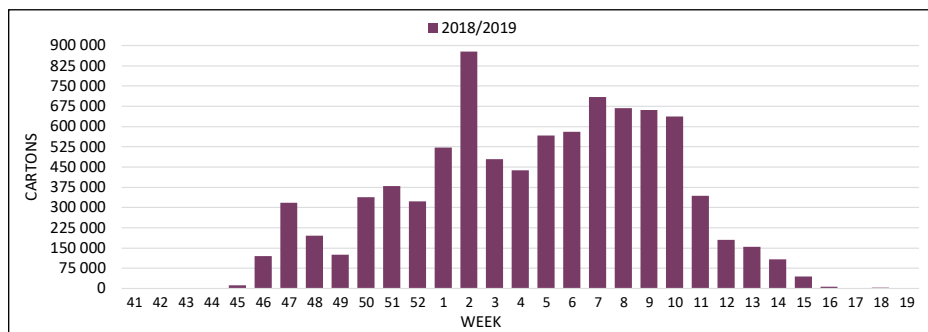
PLUM EXPORTS HISTORICAL VOLUMES

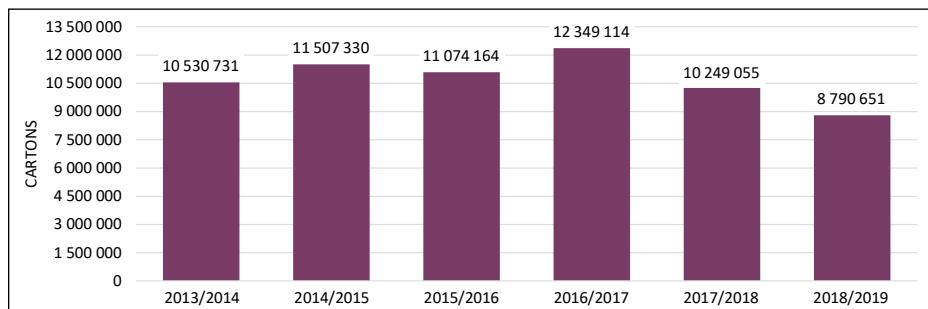

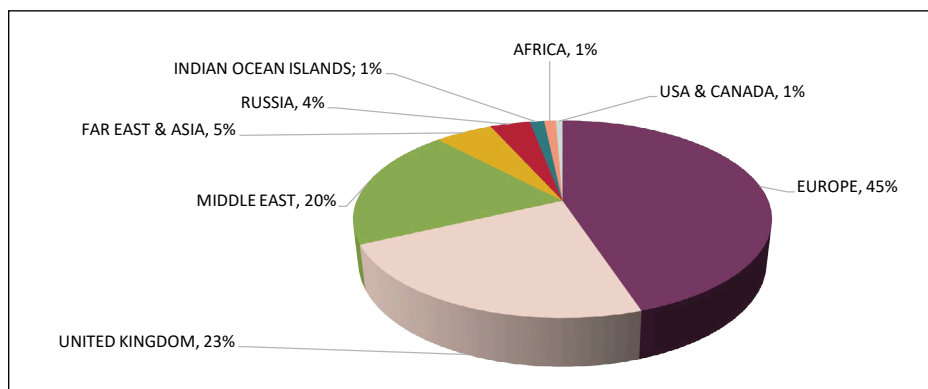

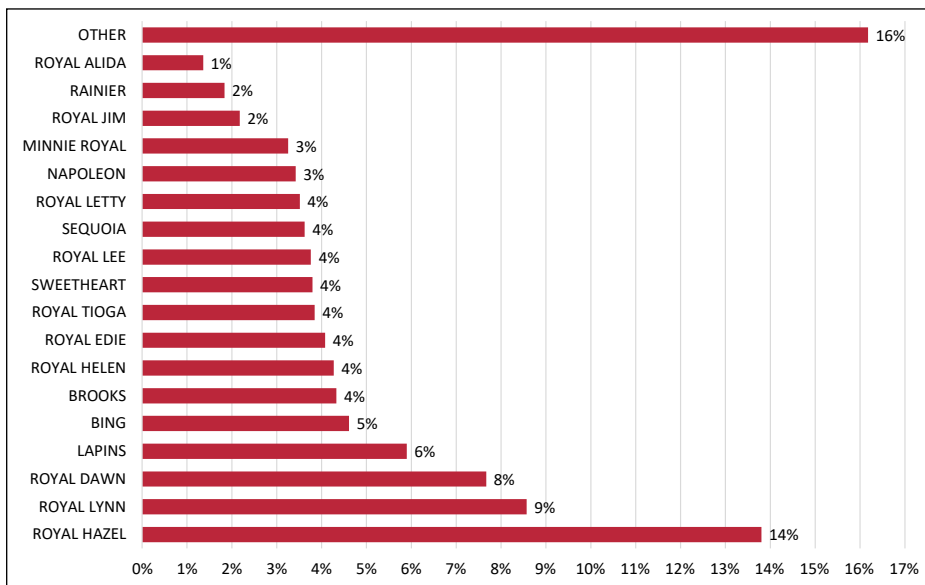

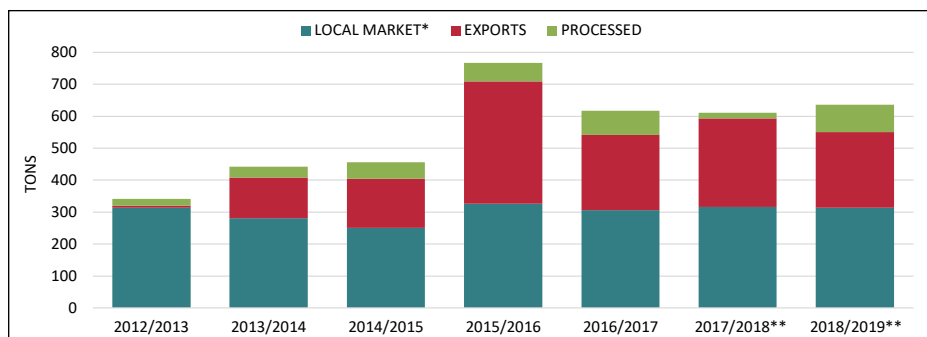

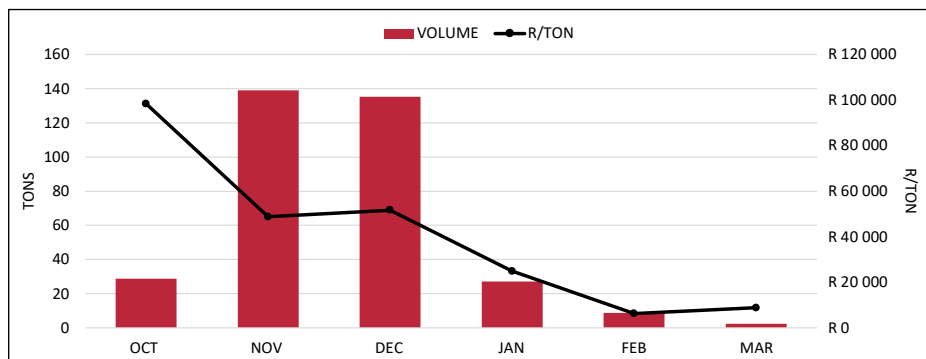

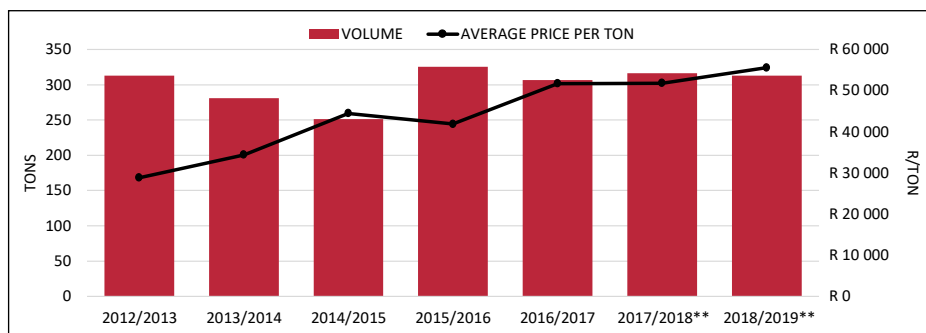
CHERRIES LOCAL MARKET SALES 2018/2019

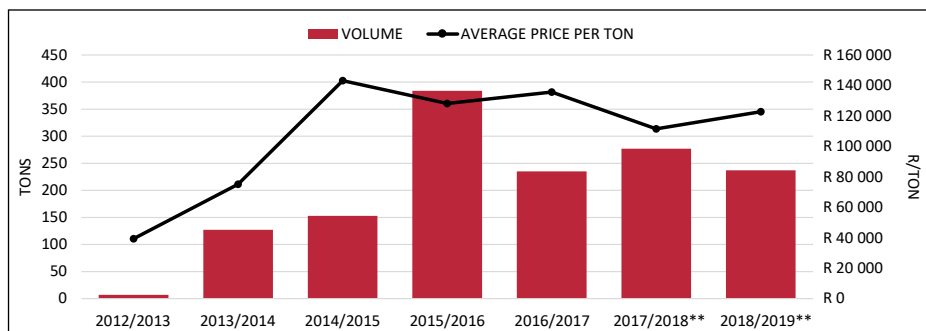

CHERRIES LOCAL MARKET HISTORICAL SALES



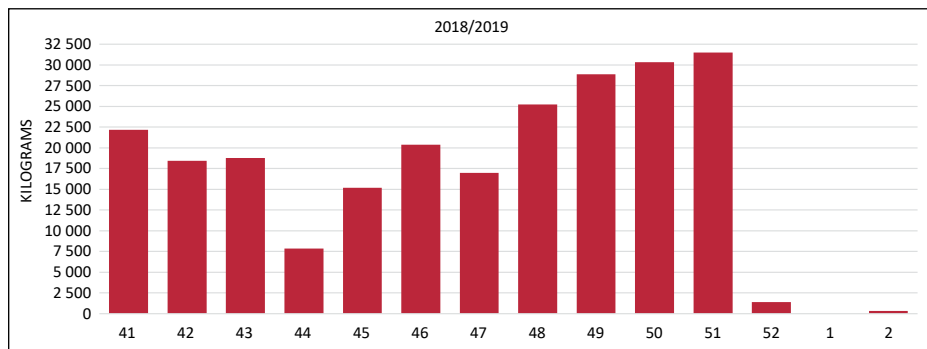

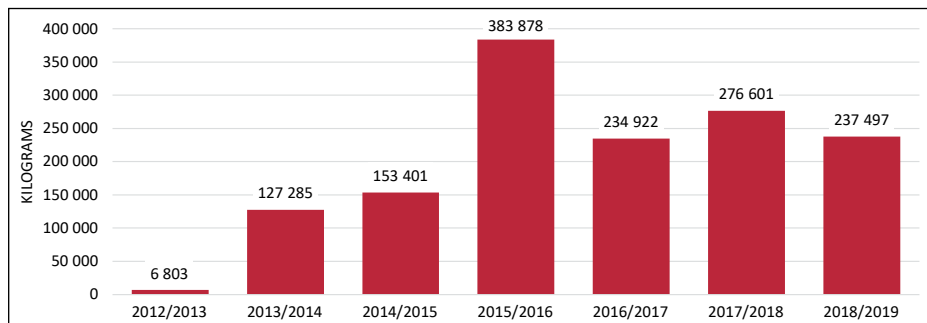

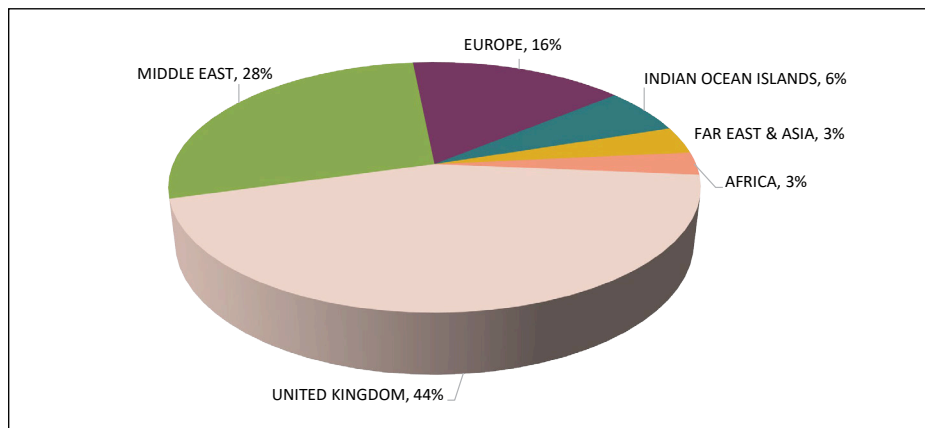

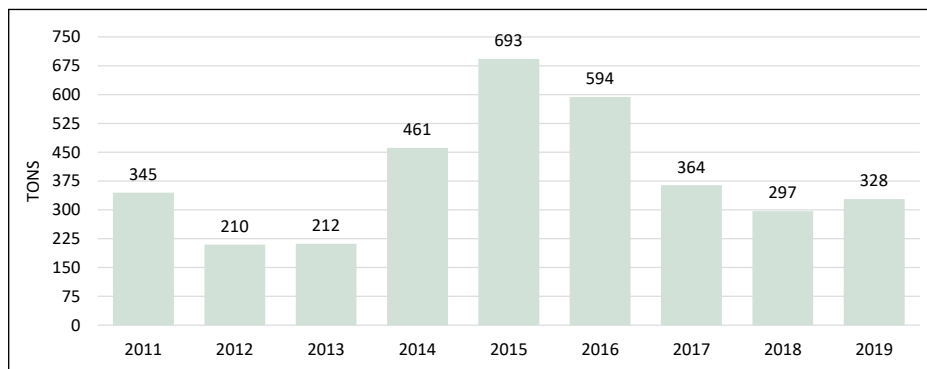

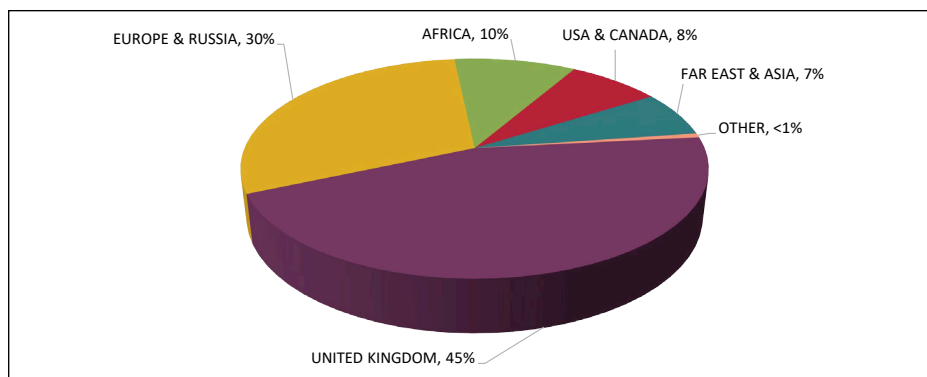


DRIED APPLE EXPORTS PER SEASON



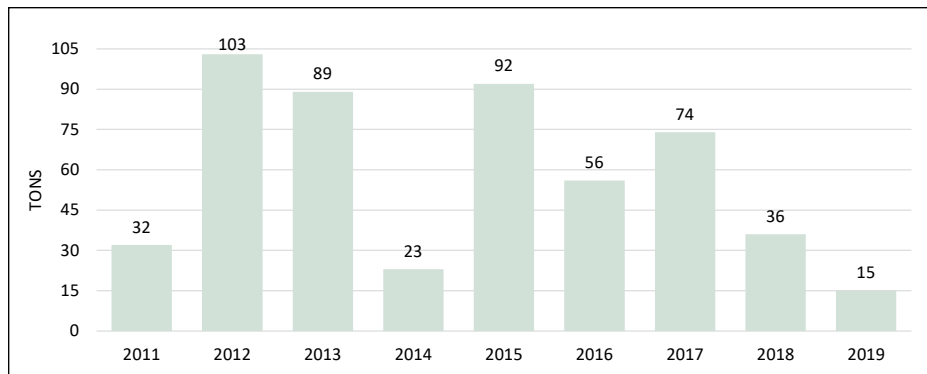

DRIED APPLE EXPORTS PER MARKET SEGMENT



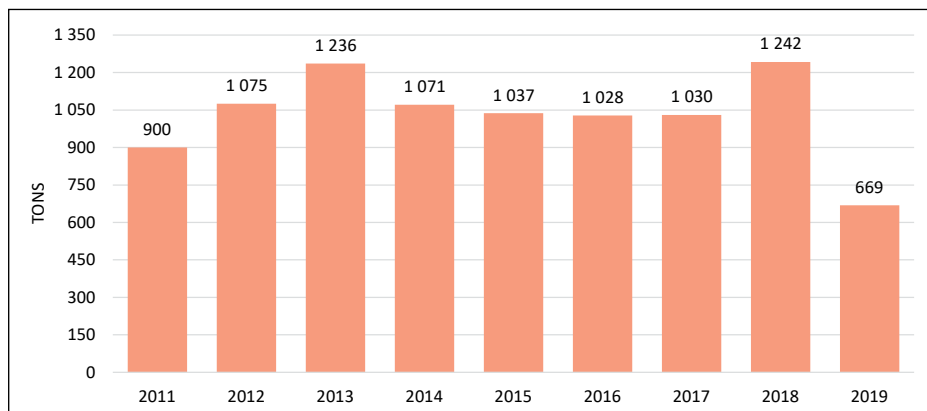

DRIED APPLE IMPORTS PER SEASON



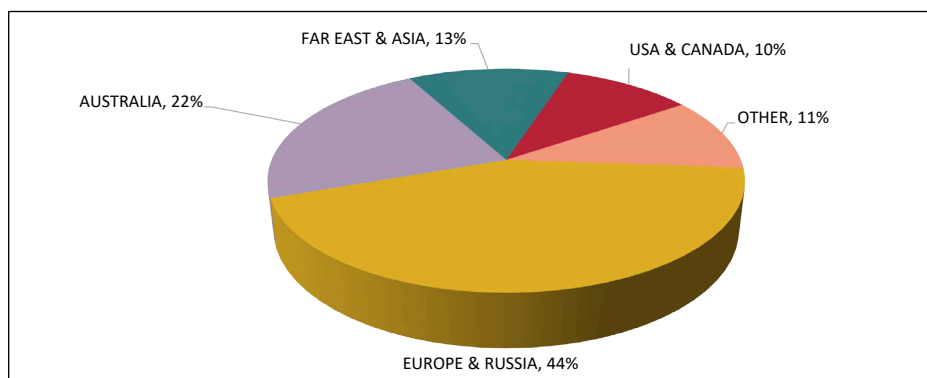

DRIED APRICOT EXPORTS PER SEASON



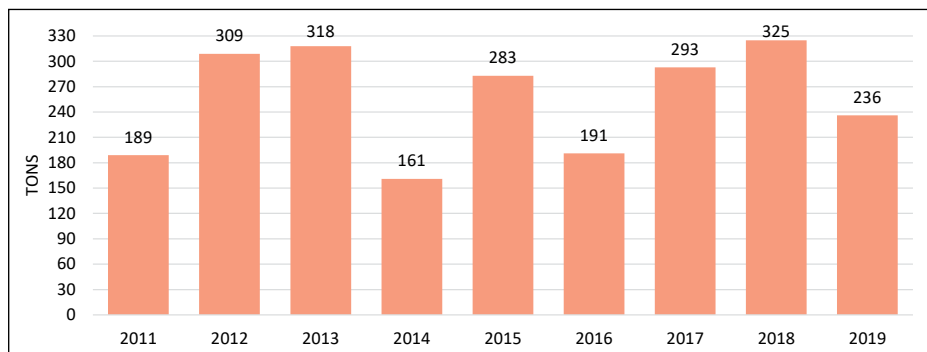

DRIED APRICOT EXPORTS PER MARKET SEGMENT



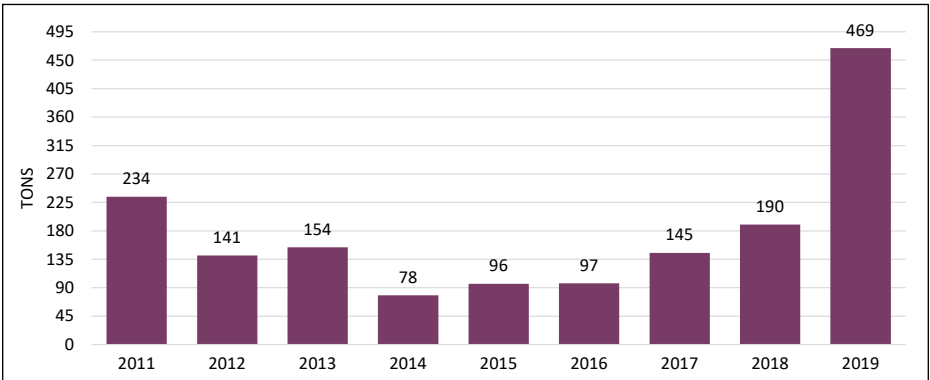

DRIED APRICOT IMPORTS PER SEASON



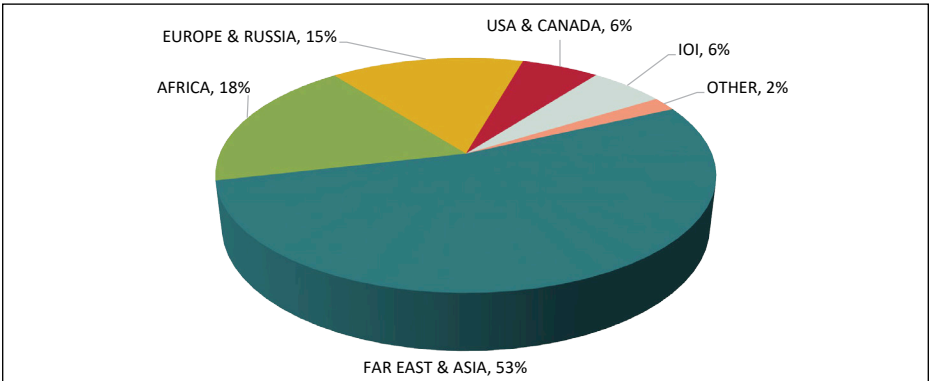

DRIED PRUNE EXPORTS PER SEASON



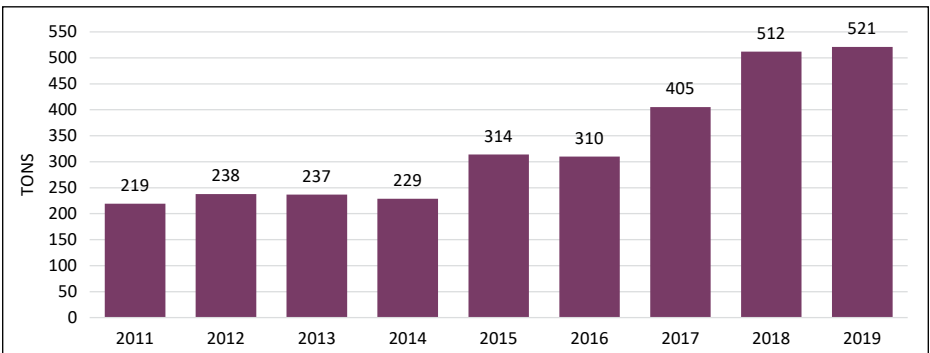

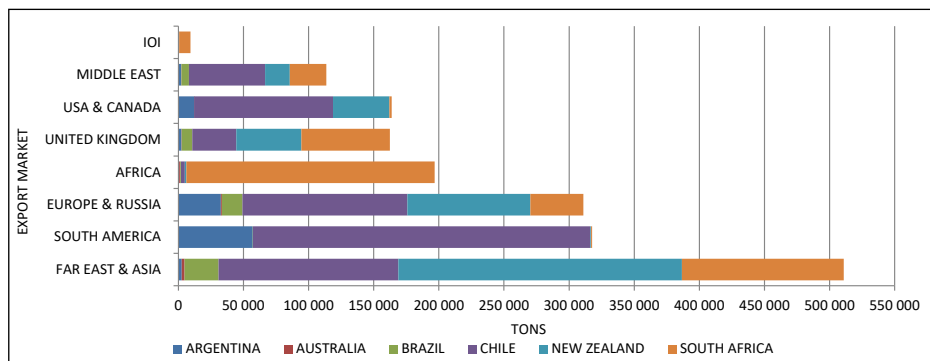

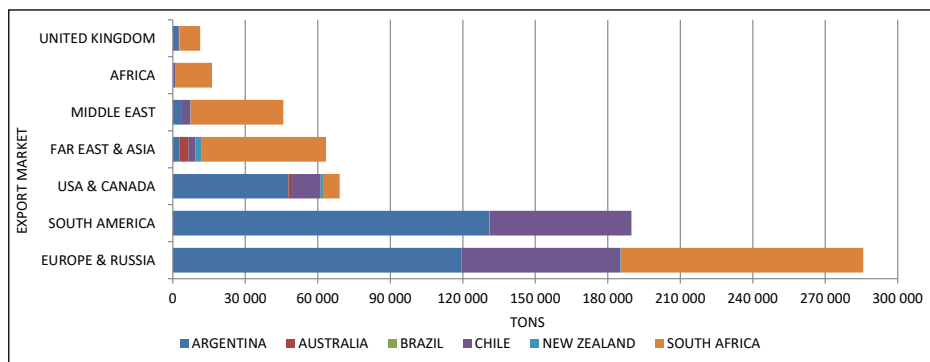

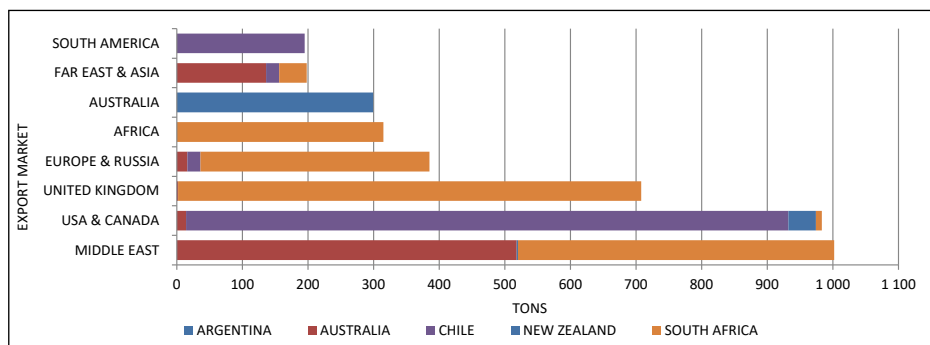

SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE PEAR EXPORTS TO MAJOR MARKETS: 2019



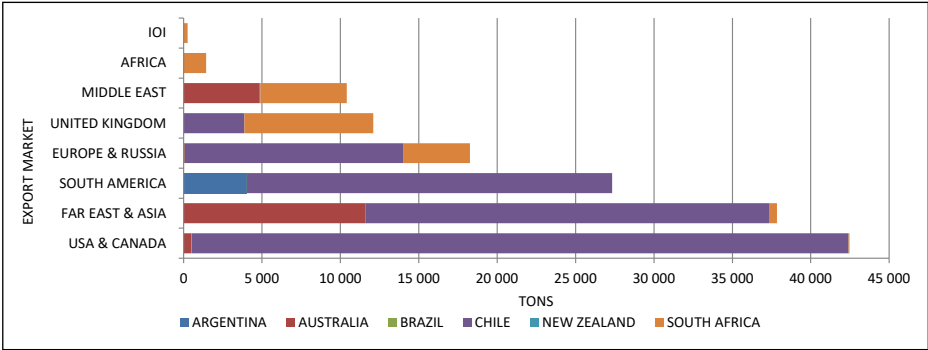

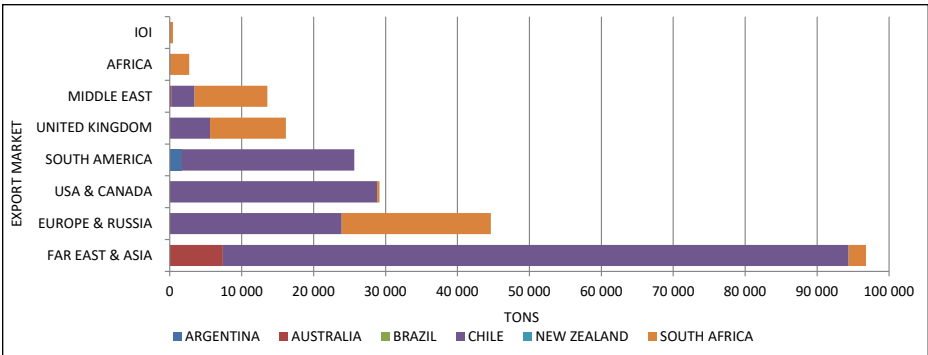

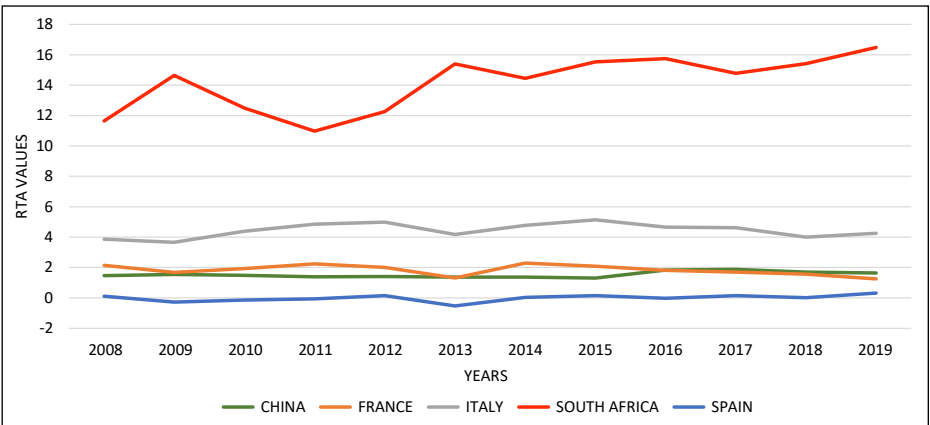

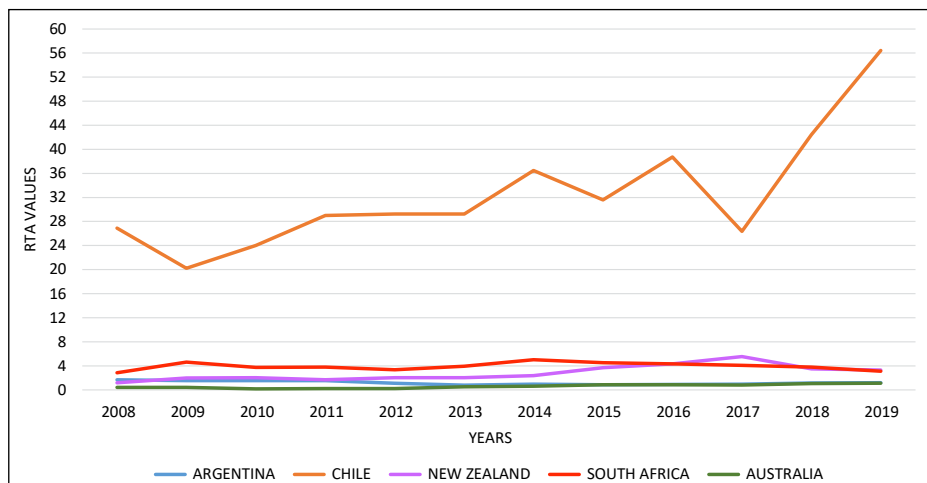

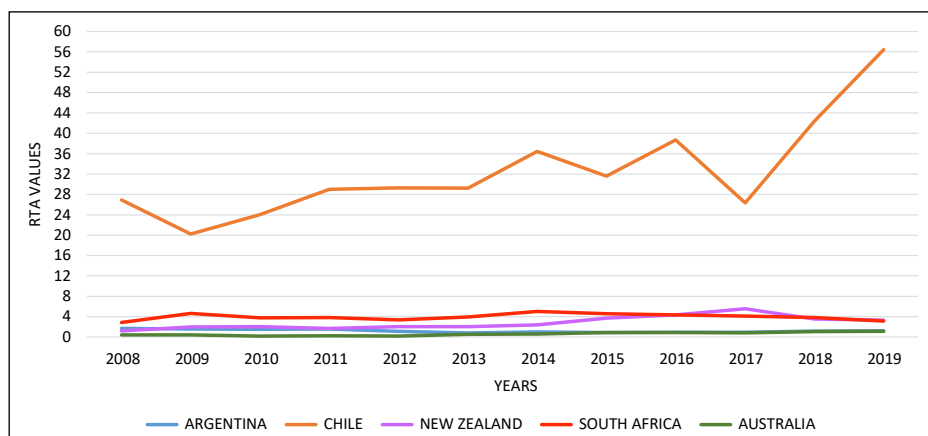
