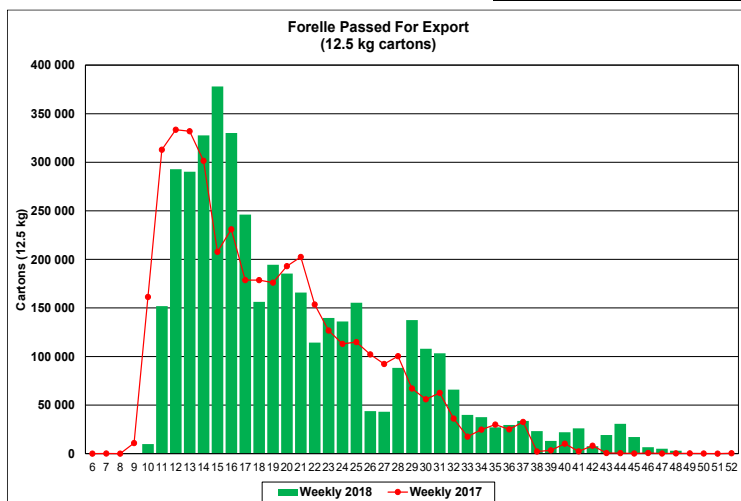
HIGHLIGHTS

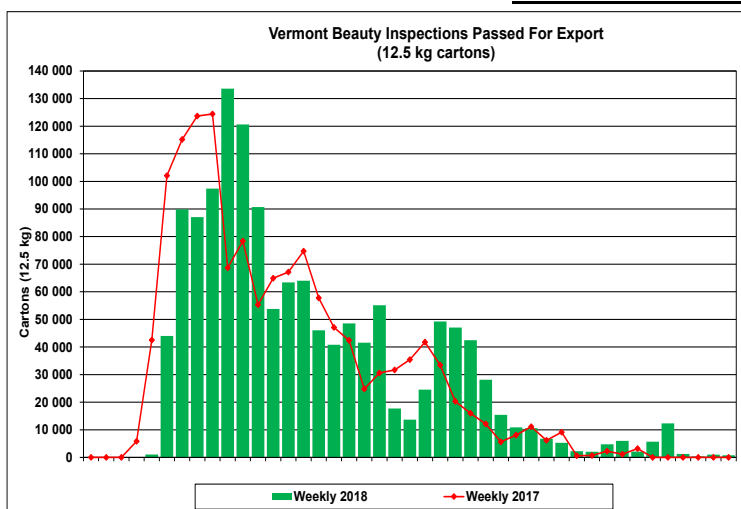
